This program provides the opportunity to acquire the skills and knowledge required to be a volunteer tutor to help clients in a classroom environment or on a 1:1 basis. The program is designed to provide literacy and/or numeracy and/or language support within a community context.

Duration:	Part-time.

Certificate IV in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) Domestic

The Certificate IV in TESOL is a program specifically designed to give students practical skills to teach English in Australia or internationally.

You will learn the latest teaching strategies and methodology in practical classes for developing the English language proficiency for a wide range of students. On successful completion of the program, you will have the necessary teaching and linguistic skills to teach English competently and confidently.

The program is offered in a blended delivery mode with most materials and assessment online. There is face-to-face observation and teaching practice.

Duration:	4 months. This program must be completed within 6 months of commencement. Ongoing intakes.

English for Migrants Certificate (Spoken and Written English)

This program is designed for adults from non-English speaking backgrounds to assist in the improvement of their English language skills.

You will progress from Certificate I through to Certificate III. While completing each Certificate, you will gain confidence in listening to and speaking English, as well as improving your reading and writing skills.

Young migrants (under 30 years old) who choose to attend this program at Bracken Ridge will be enrolled into classes with students of a similar age.

Certificate II in Transport and Distribution (Coastal Maritime Operations - Coxswain)

The objective of this competency based program is to equip you with the practical skills and underpinning knowledge to command a commercial vessel up to 12 metres in length in operational areas as defined by the USL code. *Please contact the Institute to arrange an interview prior to enrolment.*

Duration:	Part-time over 1 semester.
