The Certificate III in Beauty Services is the beginning of an exciting new career in the beauty industry. This program provides students with a range of different career options such as makeup, waxing, manicure and pedicure services.

Delivery: This program is delivered via a blend of online and face-to-face, one day per week, 9:00 am – 3.30pm.

Campus location: Ithaca, Redcliffe.

Duration: 18 months (3 semesters). Suitable for Year 11 students only.

Fees: \$1,000 semester 1, \$815 semester 2, \$815 semester 3, \$2,630 full program, plus \$37 administration fee per year.

Dress code: Black long pants and a TAFE beauty shirt, which is included in the fees. Fully enclosed, rubber-soled shoes are a workplace health and safety requirement.
