

Landscaping Assistant's Course

- *Please note: Successful completion of competencies in the course will result in a Statement of Attainment.*

This course is an introduction to the landscaping industry and includes selected units from the Certificate II in Horticulture (Landscape).

You will study a combination of theoretical and practical work and obtain a Statement of Attainment for units of competency achieved.

Delivery: This program is delivered face-to-face, one day per week from 9:00 am – 2:30 pm.

Campus location: Caboolture.

Duration: 18 months (3 semesters).

Fees: \$6 per competency, \$84 full program, plus \$37 administration fee per year.
